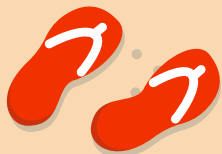

# UCSD Summer Session

## Intro to Summer Session

- ★ UCSD courses that can be taken to accelerate progress onto your degree.
- ★ Courses that may be difficult to enroll in for the regular Fall, Winter, and Spring Quarter.
- ★ Courses taken for enrichment and enhancing career prospects.
- ★ Summer Session is broken into 2 five-week sessions.
- ★ Special Summer Session also offers courses over different lengths EX: 3, 5, or 10 weeks.
- ★ Average schedule: 1 or 2 classes per session.



# When are the two Summer Sessions?

	Summer Session I	Summer Session II
Enrollment Period (Adding and Dropping courses without penalty)	UC San Diego students: April 15 - July 5  All other students: April 22 - July 5	UC San Diego students: April 15 - August 9  All other students: April 22 - August 9

Session 1: June 30–August 2

Session 2: August 4– September 6

You may enroll in up to **12** units for Session 1 and Session 2. To enroll in more than 12 units, you will need to submit a Unit Limit Exception through the [Enrollment Authorization System \(EASy\)](#) via TritonLink starting the first day of classes. Please note: Unit Limit Exceptions are rarely approved.



# Enrolling for Summer Sessions

It is similar to how you register for classes in the regular year.  
You are not required to be on campus if you taking classes remotely.  
If the building is named RCLAS, then it is a remote class.

# Tuition & Financial Aid

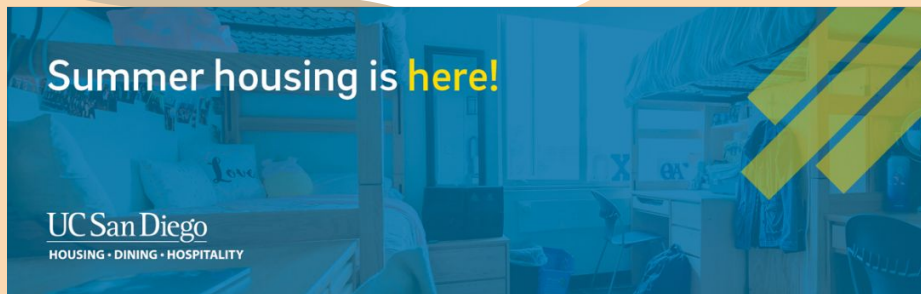
All UCSD Students have the same cost of tuition per unit for Summer Session.

Tuition per unit	Campus-based Fees*	Total per Session
\$279	\$282.43	One 4-unit course: \$1,398.43 Two 4-unit courses: \$2,514.43

- **FINANCIAL AID** may be available. To qualify for financial aid, you must enroll in a combined total of at least **6 units** during the summer sessions.
- The Federal Pell grant is pro-rated depending on enrolled and requires a total of **12 units** for the summer to receive the full summer Pell amount.

# UCSD GLOBAL SEMINARS

[studyabroad.ucsd.edu/programs/global-seminars](https://studyabroad.ucsd.edu/programs/global-seminars)

- Check the UCSD Global Seminars website for programs, financial aid options, application and deadlines!
- Global seminars are five weeks long and are taught by UCSD Professors with class sizes between 15-28 students.
- Students enroll in a package of two courses for a total of eight UCSD quarter units.
- Classes are UC transferable & **WILL** factor into your UCSD GPA.
- Acceptance on a rolling basis with final deadline of March 1st.





# Study Abroad: UCEAP & OAP

- **UCEAP (UC Education Abroad Program)**

- UC systemwide program; students from all UC campuses attend with you
- Programs are hosted by the UC system
- Academic credits earned are UC units and will factor in to your UC GPA



- **OAP (Opportunities Abroad Program)**

- Study through UCSD affiliated program partners, another US institution's program abroad, or direct-enroll in a university abroad
- Academic credits earned will be posted to your Academic History as Transfer units (will not factor into your GPA)





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# Other UC Schools

You can enroll in classes at other UC campuses.



## Other UC Campuses

- Check each UC's website for Summer Schedule of Classes
- Follow the directions to sign up as a visiting UC Student.
- Classes are UC transferable & WILL factor into your UC GPA.
- You must petition each class to meet GE, major or minor.
- Financial aid options may be available through UCSD.

# Other 4 Year Universities

- Check the school's website for their Summer Schedule of Classes and enrollment.
- Verify with [UCSD Admissions](#) that units are transferable.
- Grades will **NOT** factor into your UCSD GPA, **ONLY** units!






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# Community College

Take courses at a community college and transfer your credit to your UCSD transcript.





# Community College Summer Courses



- Around mid-April - Check YOUR Community College website for Summer course offerings, financial aid options, and also verify if they will offer specific summer courses.



- See your chosen Community College website for specific
  - instructions on enrolling in
  - classes, and how to apply for financial aid.



- If you are attending a Community College *OUTSIDE of California*, please contact UCSD Admissions to verify courses are transferable to UCSD.
- Community College grades will **NOT** factor into your UC GPA, **ONLY** units.





# Community College Summer Courses



- ASSIST.ORG (CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY COLLEGES ONLY)

Use ASSIST to verify the following information from California Community Colleges ONLY:



- ☐ “TRANSFERRABLE” .... the course will transfer units towards graduation to UCSD.

*Note: NOT all community college courses will transfer to UCSD!*

- ☐ “APPROXIMATED”... a community college course has been reviewed by UCSD faculty and determined that the community college course is comparable to a specific UCSD course. Therefore, it is approximated to a UCSD course.

*For Example: PSYC 101 from a community college may be approximated to PSYC 1 at*

*UCSD.*

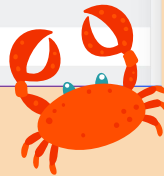

# Step 4: Transfer Credit to UCSD

## Admissions

- a. **SEND TRANSCRIPTS BY MAIL:** You must order an official transcript from your academic institution which must be sent to us directly in a sealed envelope addressed as follows:

- b. **SEND TRANSCRIPTS ELECTRONICALLY** through Parchment, a safe and secure method of requesting your official transcript(s). If your school is registered with Parchment to send electronic transcripts, please order transcripts through your school's website or create an account with Parchment directly.

We also accept transcripts electronically through eTranscriptCA, Credential Solutions, Digitary, eScripSafe, Scribbles, SCOIR, and National Student Clearinghouse if your academic institution is registered with these e-transcript vendors. Please check whether your school utilizes these e-transcript vendors to send transcripts and order through your school's transcript ordering process. Make sure you select **University of California San Diego** in La Jolla, CA as the receiving school if you choose one of these e-transcript vendors. Some vendors may list our school as UC San Diego.



## Please Keep In Mind...

Although Assist is a very useful tool to check approximations and UC transferable courses, if you are taking courses at a college that is not UCSD or a UCSD global seminar, **ALWAYS make sure they will be approved by checking with your advisors!**

You can also verify that you are enrolling in the correct courses by meeting with your major and college advisors through [vac.ucsd.edu](https://vac.ucsd.edu) or drop-in advising hours!

# Unit and Credit Information

- **Semester to Quarter units :**     $\# \text{ semester units} \times 1.5 = \# \text{ quarter units}$ .
  - For Example: 3 semester units = 4.5 quarter units
  
- **Duplication of credit:** Make sure you are aware of whether or not there are courses at UCSD that are approximated to the courses you took at another college.
  
- Check prerequisites to see if you may need to take a different class before
  
- For ALL institutions **except UCSD Summer Session and other UC campuses**, YOU MUST submit an Official Transcript after your summer grades are finalized!

# Important Dates and Deadlines

- UCSD Summer Session Enrollment
  - April 15th (**Please view your specific enrollment appointment time on Webreg!**)
- Schedule of Classes for majority of community colleges come out in spring semester
  - Varies by college so start checking in mid-April!
- When is UCSD Summer Session?
  - Summer Session 1: June 30-August 2
  - Summer Session 2: August 4- September 6
- Time of financial aid deadline?
  - Contact Financial Aid Office to verify

# Questions To Ask Yourself Before Choosing A Program

- ☐ Where do I want to take classes? Home, UCSD, abroad, elsewhere?
- ☐ Will I need on / off campus housing? Or Financial Aid?
- ☐ Do I want to add to my GPA or just get unit credit ?
- ☐ What classes? Major, GEs or electives?
- ☐ What are the deadlines for the specific program?
- ☐ Will I have any other obligations (work, research, etc) during the summer that will affect my schedule?
- ☐ Will I have the resources I may need? OASIS, tutoring, Calculus Lab, Writing Center, etc.

# Revising Academic Plans

- Taking Summer Session courses can help you towards college breadth or major requirements.
- Remember to take it into consideration when updating your Academic plan for graduation.
- Feel free to set up an appointment with Academic Advising for long term planning.

### Frequently Asked Questions

#### How do tuition and fees work during Summer Session?

- Unlike the regular academic year, UC San Diego Summer Session fees are charged based on units enrolled and sessions attended.
- Fees (and financial aid) can fluctuate based on the number of enrolled units, unit adjustments and when they are adjusted in relation to campus fee refund deadlines.

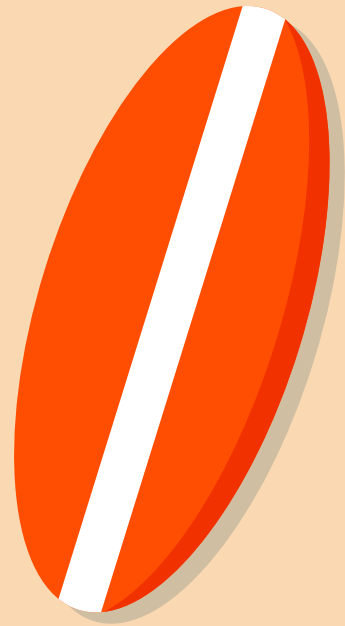
